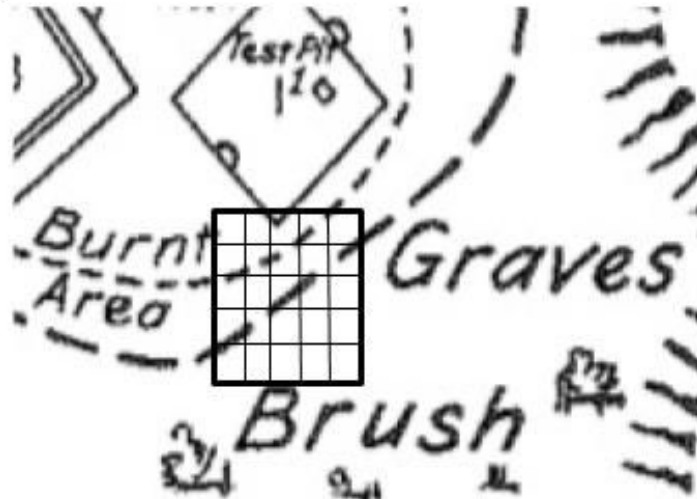
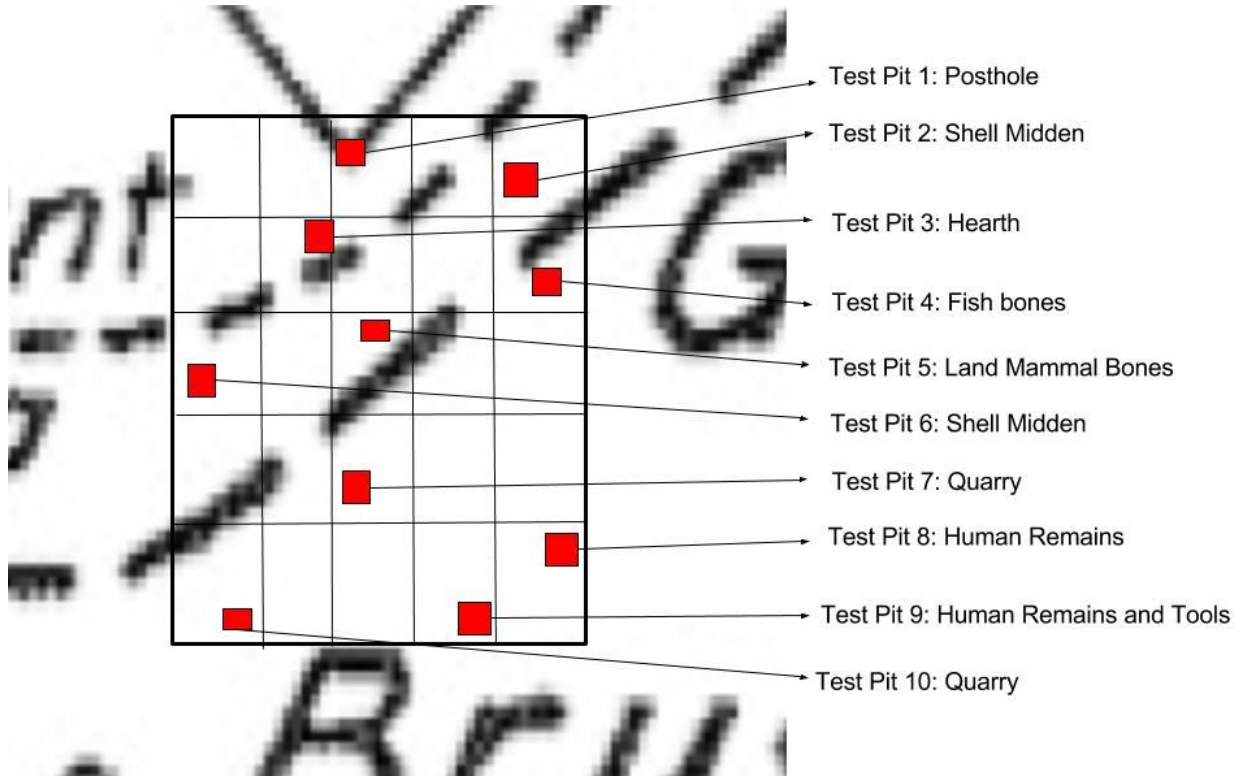


# Site Map for Planned Excavation Activity

## Site Detail of Planned Test Pit Locations and Artifacts/Features



### Data:

The data collected from Test Pits 1 - 10 will provide students with the information needed to interpret where the excavation may be located. Test Pit 1 will contain the remnants of a posthole, indicating the corner of a longhouse. Similarly, Test Pits 2, 3, 4, 5, 6 are all located within the edge of the midden remains, indicating an area where organics were disposed of. However, starting at Test Pit 7 and 10, excavations will reveal the beginnings of a small quarry or tool reworking area where chert and obsidian debris will be located. Finally, Test Pit 8 and 9 are within the extent of the burial area and will contain human remains and buried artifacts such as tools, labrets, or copper plates.

The varying artifacts in each Test Pit will allow the learners to interpret the cultural usage of the ground. They will be able to develop several hypothesis.
